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Introduction

With the Against Bubble Project financed under the ERASMUS+ Strategic Partnerships for School programme, it intends to promote actions and good practices aimed at preventing the phenomenon of bullying, in particular towards children with high functioning autism spectrum disorder (and Asperger's), but not only, involving all the figures who are part of the life context of boys and girls and who play the role of main actors in this phenomenon. Our aim is to create a good practice which can then be adopted by other European countries not participating in the project and which can also be adapted and revised to combat different types of discrimination. Through all these objectives we hope to make a strong contribution to the realization of what we hope will soon be an inclusive school, in the full sense of the term.

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What is Toolkit?

Toolkit is a tool designed to help *parents, teachers* and *school staff* to track behaviours and prevent bullying.

It will also act as a *reminder* of the guidelines learned during the training course.

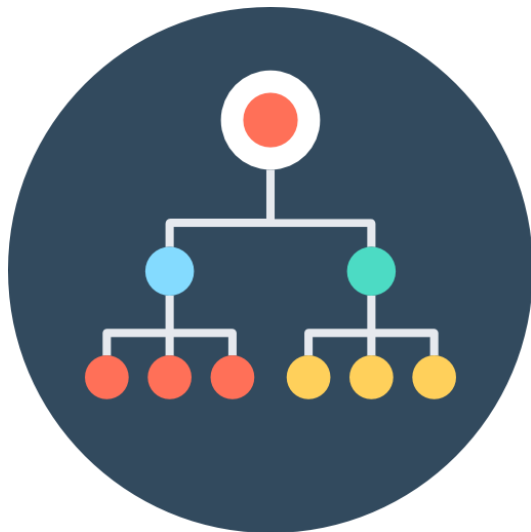

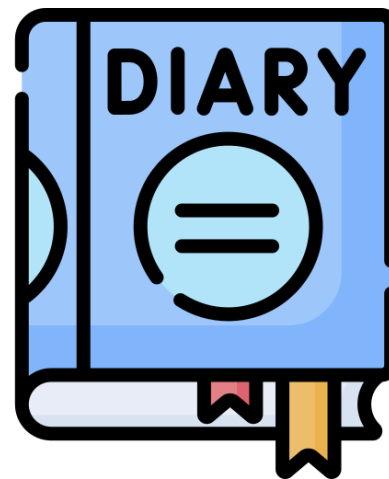

Diary

It consists of a kind of “diary” in which the target groups can record what happens in everyday life (e.g. if there have been episodes that have captured their attention or if they have noticed any abnormal behavior ...)



Questionnaire

It contains questionnaires (one of baseline and others of reports), to which you will have to respond periodically



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Guidelines & Advice

They have been extrapolated from the Training Course Materials (IO2), to serve as a reminder of what was learned during the previous training activity.

Areas of Investigation:

- Concrete Evidence
 - Lost or damaged personal items
 - Ripped dresses
 - Cuts
 - Signs of fight (livid)

- Psychological and Physical Discomfort
 - Anxiety
 - Anger/Violence




Teachers and school staff have access to the

they are responsible.



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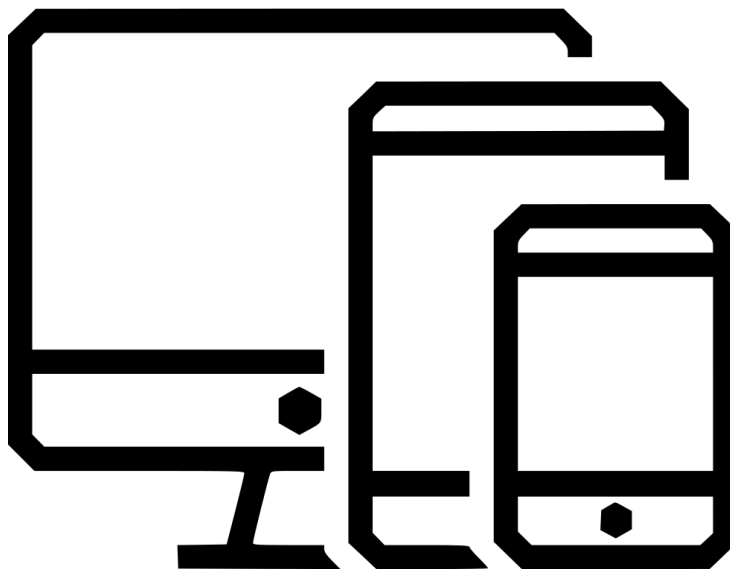




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


Clicking on the label at the top right opens a drop-down menu (circled in red) that allows the setting of the language.

You can choose between English (default language), Italian, Portuguese, Greek, Polish and Spanish.




By clicking on the button (circled in red) "Add Note", new content can be added.



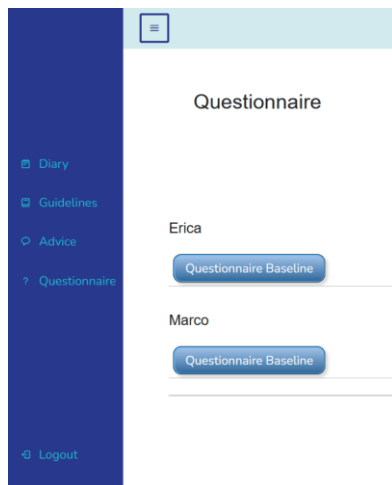

Digital version – Baseline Questionnaire

It is submitted at the beginning of the school year in order to build a basis for analysing the student's future behaviour.



Digital version – Report Questionnaire

It is submitted twice during the school year and, together with the diary, serves to investigate whether there have been any changes in the child's behaviour that might need attention.



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Each question must be marked with a score ranging from 0 to 2, or tick the "NA" field if the question is not applicable. In contrast to the above fields, the "Notes" field is optional, and may be used to provide further details or explanations.

Digital version – Superuser

All the profiles relating to a given school or class are managed by a **superuser** (head teacher, psychologist, reference teacher, etc.) who can collect the data of the various profiles relating to a single student and put act of analyzes.

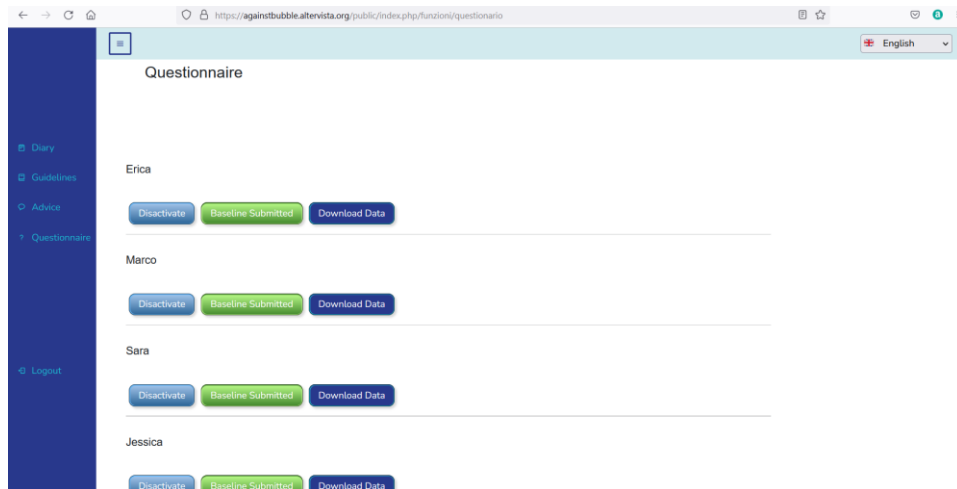

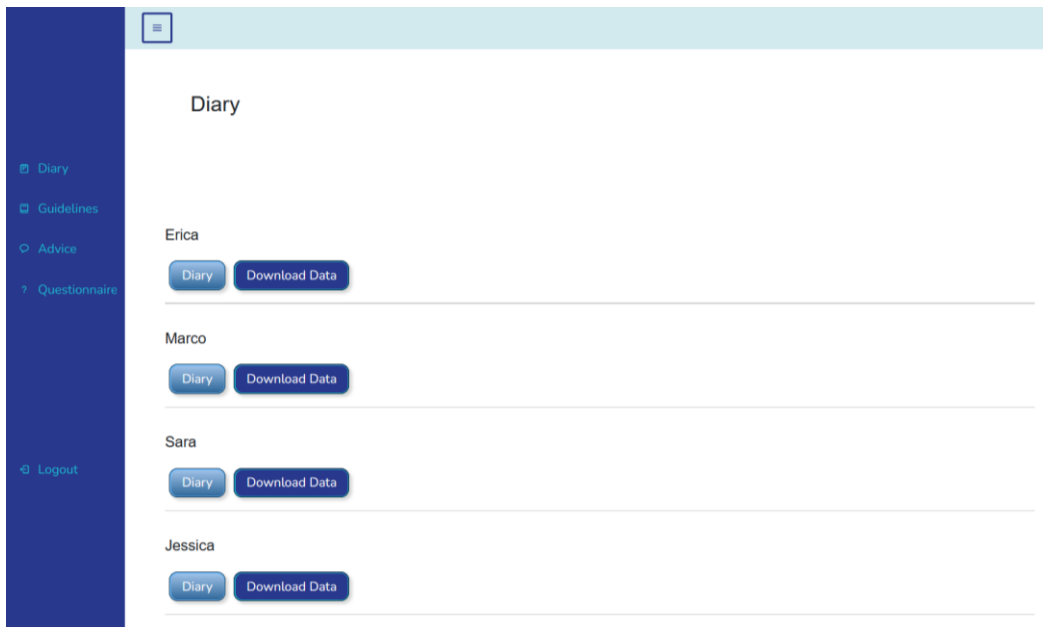

Manage and extract questionnaire data




Clicking on "Download Data" extracts a file containing all the "posts" that have been entered by parents, teachers and ATA staff relating to a given student.



In this section the superuser can manage and extract the questionnaire data of each student.

By clicking on the first label (circled in red), superuser can *activate* or *disactivate* the display of the report questionnaire of the other profiles he manages.
